FEES

- Entry Fees apply to Open show exhibitors only.
- Junior Dairy exhibitors are exempt from Entry Fees; however, they are not exempt from Late Fees.
- Per Head: \$10
- Parking Hang Tag: \$7 (Junior exhibitors receive one (1) Hang Tag with entry)
- Late Registration Fee: \$25
- RV Camper: (see Reserve RV Parking)

TOTAL PREMIUMS OFFERED

\$70,325 (This figure does not include value of other awards; i.e. ribbons, rosettes, banners, gift cards, scholarships, etc.)

PREMIUM CHECKS

- 1. Exhibitors awarded over \$599.00 must produce a valid, signed W-9 to be awarded premium (prize) monies.
- 2. Premiums will be paid within thirty (30) days after the close of the Fair.
- 3. Premium checks not cashed in ninety (90) days of issue date become void and will not be reissued.
- Lost or stolen premium checks will not be reissued past sixty (60) days of original issue date.
- 5. No claim that a premium(s) has not been paid, or that there was a discrepancy in payment of the premium(s) won, will be considered when claim is made later than November 30 following the Fair.
- 6. Premiums may be withheld if bedding area is left unclean. Junior Dairy exhibits are expected to be maintained in a clean and orderly manner. Failure to do so may result in forfeiture of premium money.

RULES and REGULATIONS

The South Carolina State Fair <u>General Rules and Regulations</u> shall apply.

EXHIBITOR ELIGIBILITY

- Open Shows Open to all dairy animals recognized by their breed specifications.
- Junior Shows Open only to South Carolina 4-H and FFA members. Exhibitors must be no younger than 5 as of show date and no older than the 4-H or FFA membership requirement age as of show date.

BREEDS

- > Ayrshire (New in 2018)
- Brown Swiss
- Guernsey
- Holstein
- Jersey

BREED ELIGIBILITY

All animals showing must be registered with their National Breed Association and have a GR status of 75% or greater.

ANIMAL REGISTRATION PAPERS

- Required for all cattle over six months of age and should remain at the SC State Fair until completion of cattle shows.
- No animals accepted with PENDING registration over six month of age.
- At the discretion of the Management, registration papers may be called for in the Show Ring on all animals showing in Group classes.

DAIRY CATTLE REGISTRATION

- The certificate of registration or signed AFFIDAVIT on each animal shown in the Junior Dairy Show must be recorded in one individual's name.
- Certificates of registrations or signed AFFIDAVIT must be present to the Superintendent upon arrival at the Fairgrounds, which proves the exhibitor to be the owner when the entry was made. No transfer slips or photocopies will be accepted.

OWNERSHIP

- Any exhibitor registering an animal in any name other than
 the bona fide owner, or owners, or showing an animal in a
 class for which it is not eligible, may, at the discretion of
 the Management, be barred from further showing, and
 any or all premiums previously awarded may be forfeited.
- In all Group Classes, only one (1) entry, per exhibitor, per class is allowed. Bring individual registration papers to show ring at time of judging. All animals per registration form must be same owner.
- The breeder of an animal is the owner of the cow at the time of service.
- Animals owned in partnership may be registered in proper classes in one (1) owner's name. Entry shall carry a footnote showing the actual ownership of the animal as appearing on the herd book records.

BLOOD TYPING

For Parentage Verification - Refer to the Association Rules.

HEALTH REQUIREMENTS

• Cattle must conform to <u>SC Animal Health Requirements</u>

- Cattle crossing state lines (out-of-state) for showing require a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI, health certificate) and official individual identification (tattoos and brands are NOT acceptable for interstate movement). Individual identification must be recorded on the CVI. The CVI must be written within thirty (30) days of the show and must accompany the cattle on arrival.
- Testing is not required for cattle originating from Brucellosis Free and Tuberculosis Free States.
 Please call Clemson Livestock Poultry Health at 803.788.2260 for additional information.
- Please indicate by checking box on entry form whether or not your animals are BST-FREE.

ENTRY REGISTRATION

Registration is required during the Open or Late Entry Registrations Periods.

- Register by the preferred method by using the <u>Online</u> <u>Entry System</u>. An email confirmation is sent at time of registration.
- You may also register using a current Dairy Cattle entry form. Deliver completed form via Postal Mail to SC State Fair Entry Office, PO Box 393, Columbia SC 29202. Please include a self-addressed, stamped business size envelope to receive a confirmation from fair when entry form is received.
- Entry forms must be received by the closing date in the Entry Office during business hours.
- Entry forms received during later registration must be accompanied by the \$25 Late Fee.
- You may also hand deliver a completed entry form Monday - Friday during regular office hours between 7:30 am and 4:00 pm to Dowling Administration Building, 1200 Rosewood Drive, Columbia SC 29201.
- Incomplete entry forms will not be processed.
- Cattle not registered in the show will not be allowed on the grounds unless permission is obtained from the Show Manager prior to the Show.

LATE ENTRY REGISTRATION

Entry forms received during late registration must be accompanied by the \$25 Late Fee.

- Late fees may be charged to a major credit card (MasterCard or Visa) or money order.
- Checks will not be accepted during the Late Entry Registration Period.
- Absolutely no entries will be accepted following the close of the registration period.

CONFIRMATION

Following close of the Late Registration Period, a Confirmation Letter, Exhibitor Card, and Vehicle Hang-Tag(s) will be mailed to all cattle exhibitors from the Show Secretary.

- The Vehicle Hang-Tag must be displayed in your vehicle in order to enter Gate 5.
- The Confirmation letter and Exhibitor Card must be presented, along with animal health papers, and Registration Certificates upon arrival at the Fairgrounds.

 The Exhibitor Card should be completed prior to arrival at the fairgrounds and will be taken up at the entrance gate.

VEHICLE HANG-TAGS

Vehicle Hang-Tags must be purchased at time of entry registration.

 Registered Junior Dairy exhibitors will receive one (1) FREE vehicle hang-tag; additional vehicle hang-tags may be ordered during the online registration process (\$7), if needed.

ARRIVAL TO FAIRGROUNDS

- All Dairy Cattle registered in both the Open and Junior shows will be received on Thursday and must be checked in no later than 12:00 Noon. No changes will be made after the books are closed. No exceptions!
- Enter at Gate 5 on Assembly Street with Vehicle Hang-Tag visible through vehicle windshield.
- Appropriate registration certificate on each animal must be presented to the Cattle Superintendent upon arrival.

PARKING

- No vehicle will be allowed to park adjacent to any of the cattle barns.
- Exhibitors will load/unload their supplies and move their trucks to the parking area designated by the Superintendent.

STALLS

- Entry fees do not dictate stall space.
- Exhibitors will receive stalls only for animals delivered to the fair.

CHECK-IN

- As entries are received by the Dairy Show manager, registrations will be checked on their respective breed association website for ownership and accuracy of information submitted.
- Registration papers showing ownership in the exhibitors name must be presented at check-in.

LIMITATIONS

A Junior Dairy exhibitor may exhibit only five (5) animals that have been transferred to his name; however; a junior exhibitor may show any of the animals of which he is the breeder and the owner.

SHOWING MULTIPLE ANIMALS

- If any Junior Dairy exhibitor enters multiple animals in any Junior Dairy Show, he/she must show at least one (1) entry in each class in which they have animals entered.
- Junior Dairy exhibitors may enter multiple animals in any Junior Dairy Show class (except showmanship classes) but each animal must be shown by a Junior Dairy exhibitor.

HERD

- While an adult exhibitor's herd is registered in the names of different members of his family, all residents on one (1) farm, and while the herd is one (1) unit, all entries may be considered as a single exhibitor for Premier Breeder, Best Three Females, and Exhibitor's Herd classes; however, entries from the Junior Show wanting to exhibit in the Open Show classes of Best Three Females and Exhibitors Herd classes must be in the individual Junior member's name and must meet the criteria of the two (2) Group Classes
- The Open entry fee must be paid when a Junior exhibitor shows in the name of a Farm.

SHOWMANSHIP CLASS

Junior Dairy Show exhibitors must show their animal in the confirmation class in order to quality for showmanship classes.

DAIRY COWS IN MILK

- Dairy cows in milk will be milked in the milking parlor unless given permission not to be milked by the Superintendent.
- All treated cows will be milked last.

DRESS CODE

- Open Dairy Show exhibitors are required to wear a show harness and must provide their own.
- Junior Dairy Show exhibitors must wear a plain collared shirt while exhibiting, no caps to be worn in the ring.

CARE, FEED, & BEDDING OF CATTLE

- Owner is responsible for feed, bedding, and care his animals.
- Cattle are to be watered and fed in stalls or at tie-outs, not on wash rack, in aisles or doorways.
 Each exhibitor is requested to limit the amount of feed and hay brought into the show barn to one (1) days' supply.
- A \$10.00 per head, per day charge will be assessed to 4-H, FFA, or adult exhibitors who fail to feed and water their cattle or maintain a clean exhibit.

BEDDING

- No straw bedding allowed in barns;
- No straw in tie-outs;
- Initial bedding free:
- Additional shavings available at \$5.00 per bale.

CHUTES

- No blocking chutes will be allowed in the barns.
- They may be placed in a designated area adjacent to the barn.

PUBLIC DISPLAY & RESPONSIBILITY

- Animals in this department will be on display to the public from 8:30 am to 9:30 pm daily.
- Exhibitors will be under control and direction of the Superintendent, but the Fair Association will be, in no case, responsible for any loss or damage that may occur.
- Any animal deemed unsafe or ill will not be able
- Each exhibitor will be responsible for any loss, injury or damage done by or arising from any animals exhibited by him.
- Animals must be shown by 4-H or FFA member without assistance.
- Junior Dairy exhibitors must show at least one (1) entry in each class in which they have an animal entered.
- If any Junior Dairy exhibitor enters multiple animals in the Junior Dairy Show, he/she must show at least one (1) entry in each class in which they have animals entered.
- Junior exhibitors may enter multiple animals in any Junior Dairy Show class (except showmanship classes) but each animal must be shown by a junior exhibitor.
- Any animal deemed unsafe, uncontrollable or unhealthy by the Fair Veterinarian, and/or Cattle Superintendent will be sent back to the barn and/or home (at the discretion of the people listed above) and will not return this year's fair.

VETERINARIAN POLICY

 Names and telephone numbers of qualified local veterinarians will be posted in the Superintendent's office. Exhibitor is responsible for payment of any veterinary care performed on their animal(s) from an on-site veterinarian.

MISTREATMENT OF ANIMAL

 Fair management reserves the right to remove any exhibitor from the grounds who is deemed to be mistreating any animal.

SICK ANIMALS

 May be released immediately, if a statement signed by a veterinarian is presented to the Superintendent.

HOT SHOWERS

 Available for cattle exhibitors daily from 8:00 am - 10:30 am and 5:00 pm - 10:30 pm

NO DOGS OR PETS

- Other than service animals, no dogs or pets shall be permitted on the fairgrounds or in exhibit buildings during the fair except when confined within the campgrounds or unless they are part of an authorized act or exhibit.
- Pets in the campgrounds must be leashed at all times.

SIGNS

The SC State Fair Management reserves the right to refuse permission for any individual exhibitor to erect or display any sign of objectionable size or content.

NOTICES

- NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES PERMITTED ON THE FAIRGROUNDS.
- SMOKING IS NOT PERMITTED IN ANY BUILDING ON THE FAIRGROUNDS OR IN KIDDYLAND.
- THE DISTRIBUTION OF EDIBLE PRODUCTS IS PROHIBITED IN ALL LIVESTOCK AREAS.

RULE INTERPRETATION

Show officials reserve the final and absolute right to interpret these rules and regulation and to settle and determine all matters, questions or differences in regard thereto or connection with no incident to the show.

RELEASE

- Cattle will be released at the conclusion of activities on Sunday.
- Any exhibitor removing animals without official release, not maintaining cattle and space, or failing to remove manure from exhibit to proper area, will forfeit all premiums (prize monies).

DAIRY PRODUCTION RECOGNITION

- 1. The premium will be increased by 50% on any animal showing in the Milking Cow Classes, which has a 305 day, 2X M.E. record of 2,000 pounds of milk above the State DHIA average for the breed for the prior testing year. The premium will be increased by 50% on any animal showing in the Milking Cow Classes, which has a 305 day, 2X M.E. record of 2,000 pounds of milk above the State DHIA average for the breed for the prior testing year.
- The lactation considered will be the most recent completed record while officially projected first lactation records may also qualify.
- Either the DHIA Individual Cow Page (DHI-203) or a monthly Report (DHI-200) must be presented to the Superintendent for verification prior to the show.
- 4. No handwritten or phone call information will be accepted.

To be qualified for production recognition, the following 2X M.E. records must be met in pounds:

- AYRSHIRE 17,000 LBS.
- BROWN SWISS 17,500 LBS.
- ➤ GUERNSEY 17,250 LBS.
- ➤ HOLSTEIN 20,475 LBS.
- JERSEY 18,451 LBS.

TOP AWARDS

- PREMIER BREEDER BANNERS (4) Presented by The South Carolina State Fair to the Premier Breeder in each dairy breed.
- PREMIER EXHIBITOR AWARD: The exhibitor winning the most points on no more than six animals owned and exhibited by himself/herself in the open single classes shall be designated the Premier Exhibitor. The scale of points will be the same as that for determining Premier Breeder.
- THE SOUTH CAROLINA GUERNSEY ASSOCIATION AWARD: Awarded to the Open Guernsey Show Grand Champion, sponsored by Doug Sims, Clinton SC.
- The South Carolina Guernsey Association will present the following 4-H Awards:
 - THE MARVIN J. HAMM AWARD sponsored by Thomas H. Kelly Family of Union, SC and awarded to the Junior Guernsey Showmanship winner.
 - THE THOMAS H. KELLY, SR. AWARD sponsored by Thomas H. Kelly Family of Union, SC and awarded to the Junior Guernsey Showmanship winner.
 - THE MARFRED FARM AWARD sponsored by Marfred Farms of Saluda, SC and awarded to Guernsey Junior Champions and Grand Champions in the Junior Show.
 - THE MELLDORO FARM AWARD sponsored by Mellwood Coleman Family of Saluda, SC and awarded to the Novice Guernsey Showmanship winner.
 - THE LUSHACRES FARM AWARD sponsored by Lushacres Farm of Clinton, SC in memory of Mr. and Mrs. Herbner and awarded to top individuals of 4-H.
 - Guernsey Heifer Project classes in Junior Show.
- THE EASTGLEN FARM AWARD: Awarded to the Open Jersey Show Grand Champion Female
- PREMIER BREEDER'S AWARD: The Breeder winning the most points on no more than six animals in the open single classes, exhibited by himself/herself and/or other exhibitors shall be designated the Premier Breeder. The point system for determining Premier Breeder is as follows:

 - Points Senior Females 20 18 16 14 12 10 8 6 4 2

SHOWMANSHIP AWARDS

JUNIOR DAIRY SHOWMANSHIP REQUIREMENTS & SCORECARD

- Junior Dairy members will be allowed to compete in only one (1) showmanship class, regardless of breed.
- 2. Animals must be shown by owner.
- A show harness must be worn by the 4-H'er with the correct number from the type class for the animal he/she is exhibiting.
- Animals to be shown in Showmanship classes must be registered during check-in.

Showmanship divisions will be judged according to the following scorecard:

- ➤ Showmanship ability 70 points
- > Appearance of animal 20 points
- Appearance of exhibitor 10 points

SHOWMANSHIP DIVISIONS

- 1. NOVICE: For Junior members between five (5) and ten (10) years of age as of show date. The top two (2) individuals from the Novice Division Showmanship class will be eligible to compete for the Dixon and Anne Lee Novice Showmanship Award. These individuals will not be placed during the competition, but will be placed during the Lee Award competition. Previous Dixon & Lee Award winners will not be allowed to compete in any showmanship classes, but may move up to a Junior Showmanship class.
- 2. JUNIOR: For Junior members between eleven (11) and fourteen (14) years of age as of show date. The top two (2) individuals from the Junior Division Showmanship class will be eligible to compete for the Fred E. Pardue Junior Showmanship Award. These individuals will not be placed during the breed competition but will be placed during the Pardue Award competition. Previous Fred E. Pardue Showmanship Award winners will not be allowed to compete in any Junior Showmanship classes but may move up to a Senior Showmanship class.
- 3. SENIOR: For Junior members between fifteen (15) and twenty (20) years of age as of show date. The top two (2) individuals from the Senior Division Showmanship Classes of each breed will be eligible to compete for the Commissioner's Cup Senior Showmanship Award. These individuals will not be placed during the competition for the Commissioner's Cup. Previous winners will not be allowed to compete in any senior showmanship classes. The Commissioner's Cup is sponsored by Bush River Jerseys, Newberry, SC

 COLLEGIATE: For Junior members between seventeen (17) and twenty-one (21) years of age as of show date and must be enrolled in a college.

4-H DAIRY HEIFER PROJECT

The South Carolina State Fair supports the South Carolina 4-H/FFA Dairy Heifer Project by sponsoring up to four (4) heifers each year. These four (4) animals are purchased by the SC State Fair. The youth selected to receive these scholarship animals will be notified and receive their heifer at the Project Kick-Off each year.

4-H DAIRY HEIFER PROJECT "Win-A-Heifer" REQUIREMENTS:

- Project members are eligible to win a scholarship heifer no more than two (2) times.
- 2. Must be a current 4-H or FFA member.
- Must submit a recommendation letter from their county agent or agricultural teacher with the application. The county agent or agricultural teacher is to certify that the 4-H/FFA member recommended can provide quality care for the heifer.
- Must submit most recent 4-H Dairy Heifer Project or Dairy Project record book with the application.
- 5. Must submit a 100-500 word essay about their experiences in the 4-H dairy program and why they feel they should be awarded a scholarship heifer. Project heifer at the South Carolina State Fair Junior Dairy Show the following two (2) years.
- Recipients of the scholarship heifers will be members of the 4-H
 Dairy Heifer Project, sign a Heifer Project Agreement Form and be
 required to abide by all heifer project guidelines.
