- **Open Entry Registration: July 1 - Sept. 1** (entry registration forms must be received by this date to avoid Late Fee)
- **Late Entry Registration: Sept. 2 - Sept. 8** (\$25 Late Fee imposed)
- **Entry Tags** will be attached to art work upon delivery;
- **Delivery Days – Enter North Gate**
 - Sunday, Sep 23 - 1:00 pm to 6:00 pm
 - Monday, Sep 24 - 9:30 am to 6:00 pm
 - Tuesday, Sep 25 - 9:30 am to 6:00 pm

PREMIUM CHECKS

1. Premium checks will be dispersed to winners at the Student Art Preview. Unclaimed checks will be mailed to winners the following day.
2. Exhibitors awarded over \$599.00 must produce a valid, signed W-9 to be awarded premium (prize) monies.
3. Premiums will be paid within thirty (30) days after the close of the Fair.
4. Premium checks not cashed in ninety (90) days of issue date become void and will not be reissued.
5. Lost or stolen premium checks will not be reissued past sixty (60) days of original issue date.
6. No claim that a premium(s) has not been paid, or that there was a discrepancy in payment of the premium(s) won, will be considered when claim is made later than November 30 following the Fair.

GENERAL RULES

[The South Carolina State Fair General Rules and Regulations shall apply.](#)

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- Exhibitor must be a resident of South Carolina attending public, private or home school in grades Kindergarten - Twelfth grade (K-12);
- Exhibitor must be under age nineteen (19) and not graduated from high school.

ENTRY REGISTRATION

- Registration is required during the Open or Late Entry Registrations Periods.
- Register by the preferred method by using the [Online Entry System](#)
- Group (Family/School/Home School) entries should be registered by an adult (parent or teacher) using the GROUP (Family/School/Home School) Division when entering online.
- An individual may register using the INDIVIDUAL Division when entering online.
- You may also register using a current South Carolina State Fair Official Student Art Entry form.

- Entry forms received during later registration must be accompanied by the \$25 Late Fee.

- Incomplete entry forms will not be processed.

ENTRY REGISTRATION CONFIRMATION

- Online entry registrations are automatically confirmed at time of submission.
- Please print and bring your confirmation on Delivery Day with your artwork.
- Exhibitors who postal mail their entry registrations and desire a confirmation must include a self-addressed, stamped, business size envelope.
- Please do not telephone the Fair or Entry Office for confirmation.

LATE ENTRY REGISTRATIONS

- Entry forms received during late registration must be accompanied by the \$25 Late Fee.
- Late fees may be charged to a major credit card (MasterCard or Visa) or money order. Checks will not be accepted during the Late Entry Registration Period.
- Absolutely no entries will be accepted following the close of the registration period.

LIMITATIONS & REQUIREMENTS

- Limit of one (1) entry per student; please be careful to list the correct spelling of each student name at time of registration as there will be no corrections made to entry tags, winner announcements, or checks.
- Students registering via their school/group may not register as an Individual.
- Duplicate exhibitor name entries will be juried out.
- Unlimited number of GROUP entries are permitted; however, only one (1) entry per student will be permitted. This means only one (1) 2-D or one (1) 3-D or one (1) photograph; a student cannot be registered in more than one Division or Section, nor may the same student be registered by different teachers or as an Individual.
- Only individual completed artwork will be accepted.
- No pieces completed by a group may be entered.
- Artwork must be original and have been completed in the last school year.
- Artwork must be LABELED (see Preparing Artwork for Delivery below).
- Teachers should jury their student artwork and not bring multiple quantities of the same lesson.
- Artworks are juried (selected for exhibition) and judged for awards.
- Works juried out (not selected for exhibition) will be stored in a safe location until claimed on the release dates.
- Art of the Camellia entries should follow 2-D/3-D requirements.

PREPARING ARTWORK FOR DELIVERY

- Please check spelling of names and grade levels before submitting entry registration.
- There will be no substitutions of student artwork.
- Bring a copy of your entry form when delivering and claiming artwork.
- INDIVIDUAL artwork should be labeled on back of artwork with the student name, grade level, parent name, and phone. *(SEE LINKS BELOW)*
- GROUP artwork should be stacked by grade level.
- A label should be attached to back of each student's artwork that includes a school stamp or label with the student name, grade level, school/family/group name, and adult contact name and phone number' this information should match the data on entry form. Do not attach labels to front of artwork.

SECTION 0206 – 2-Dimensional

SECTION NOTES

1. Maximum size allowed 22"x28";
2. No framed artwork;
3. Artwork to be mounted securely on poster board, foam board, or matt board;
4. Plastic mounting tags may be attached on the back for hanging;
5. Labels should be attached on back of artwork securely and correspond with the direction the piece should be hung;
6. It is recommended that black poster board or matt board not be used because of the black hanging panels;
7. Not acceptable for hanging: construction paper or any light weight paper, card board, or framed artwork.

SECTION 0207 – 3-Dimensional

SECTION NOTES

1. Bases for mounted sculptural forms can be no smaller than 5 inches and no larger than 24 inches.
2. When gluing a piece to card board or matt board, the base should not exceed more than three (3) inches from the piece to the edge of the base.
3. All mountings must be sturdy.
4. Un-mounted sculptural forms must be able to stand alone without wobbling or tipping over.
5. Relief pieces such as masks, clay plaques, mosaics, etc. should have some form of hanging device firmly attached to back of artwork.
6. Mobiles or fiber hangings must also be equipped with a firmly attached hanging device.
7. Labels should be attached securely to the bottom or back of artwork.

SECTION NOTES

1. Maximum size allowed 22"x28";
2. Black & white, color, hand-tinted, digitally-altered photographs, and computer generated/digitally-altered prints;
3. Photo should be taken or manipulated by student without adult input.
4. No framed photography;
5. Photo to be mounted securely on poster board, foam board, or matt board.
6. Plastic mounting tags may be attached on the back for hanging.
7. Labels should be attached on back of artwork securely and correspond with the direction the piece should be hung.
8. It is recommended that black poster board, matt board or foam board not be used because of the black hanging panels.
