PREMIUM CHECKS

1. Exhibitors awarded over \$599.00 must produce a valid, signed W-9 to be awarded premium (prize) monies.
2. Premiums will be paid within thirty (30) days after the close of the Fair.
3. Premium checks not cashed in ninety (90) days of issue date become void and will not be reissued.
4. Lost or stolen premium checks will not be reissued past sixty (60) days of original issue date.
5. No claim that a premium(s) has not been paid, or that there was a discrepancy in payment of the premium(s) won, will be considered when claim is made later than November 30 following the Fair.

RULES and REGULATIONS

The South Carolina State Fair [General Rules and Regulations](#) shall apply.

ENTRY REGISTRATION

Entry Registration is required during either the Open or Late Entry Registration Period.

Register by the preferred method by using the [Online Entry System](#) or one may also register using a current South Carolina State Fair Official Swine entry form. Deliver completed form via Postal Mail to: **SC State Fair, Entry Office, P. O. Box 393, Columbia SC 29202.**

One may also hand deliver a completed entry form Monday - Friday during regular office hours between 7:30 am and 4:00 pm to: **Dowling Administration Building, 1200 Rosewood Drive, Columbia SC 29201.**

- Entry registration forms must be received by the closing date in the Entry Office during business hours.
- Entry registration forms received during late registration must be accompanied by the \$25 Late Fee.
- Incomplete entry forms will not be processed.

ENTRY REGISTRATION CONFIRMATION

- Online entry registrations are automatically confirmed by return email at time of submission.
- Please print and bring your confirmation on Delivery Day.
- Exhibitors who postal mail their entry registrations and desire a confirmation must include a self-addressed and stamped business size envelope.

- Please do not telephone the Fair or Entry Office

REGISTRATION NOTES

1. IMPORTANT: Anyone showing swine in any class, including Showmanship, is considered an exhibitor and must be registered under his name to receive premiums and awards, this includes persons showing in Adult Showmanship, Costume, and Barrow classes.
2. Persons showing in Adult Showmanship, Costume, and Barrow classes must be registered during the Entry Registration Period in order to receive payment of premiums. Any NON-registered person participating in these classes may receive ribbons and/or rosettes; however, all premiums will be forfeited.
3. Junior Show entries in Open Show must be registered in farm or partnership, or be a child of the owner.
4. Entry Registration is limited to two (2) entries per exhibitor in each class.

HEALTH REGULATIONS

1. Swine are to be inspected on the farm of origin by a veterinarian prior to shipment and receive a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI)* valid for 30 days and have Official Identification. Official ID must be recorded on the CVI*. (*Or approved movement documentation.)
2. Official Identification for swine: Official ear tags: Imprinted with Official Ear Tag US Shield and nationally unique official animal identification number. Examples - NUES, Official AIN tags, Official RFID tags
3. Ear notching if the ear notching has been recorded in a swine registry association's book of record;
4. Tattoos on the ear or inner flank if the tattoo has been recorded in a swine registry association's book of record;
5. USDA back tags for moving directly to slaughter, not exhibition;
6. Group/Lot Identification for moving directly to slaughter, not Exhibition.
7. Swine imported into SC that are consigned directly to slaughter are not required to have a CVI.
8. Animal Registration papers must be in the name of the individual, FFA Chapter, 4-H Club or farm.
9. Age shown on the certificate must conform strictly with the animal. Telegrams or letters from Breeders' Association will not be considered.
10. Exhibitors must furnish their own troughs and are responsible for keeping pens clean and in good condition.
11. All Health Regulations are subject to change by Clemson University Livestock-Poultry Health

Division.

OUT-OF-STATE SWINE: Please provide the following information to your veterinarian as he/she completes your interstate Certificate of Veterinary Inspection to come to the SC State Fair.

1. Certificate of Veterinary Inspection - CVI (valid for 30 days) with destination listed as SC State Fair, 1200 Rosewood Dr., Columbia, SC 29201. Official Identification must be recorded on the CVI for each animal.
2. Official Identification for swine:
 - a. Official ear tags: imprinted with Official Ear tag US Shield and nationally unique official animal identification number; Examples - NUES, Official AIN tags, Official RFID tags
 - b. Ear notching if the ear notching has been recorded in a swine registry association's book of *record;
 - c. Tattoos on the ear or inner flank if the tattoo has been recorded in a swine registry association's book of *record. *records must be available for review
3. Entry permit required for all out-of-state feeding or breeding swine (issued by the State Veterinarian, call 803-788-2260).
4. To obtain a SC entry permit the swine must originate from a Validated Swine Brucellosis-Free herd and Qualified Pseudorabies-Negative herd or tested negative within 30 days *record of testing must be recorded on the CVI).
5. No testing required if originating in a commercial swine operation located in a Swine Brucellosis and Pseudorabies Free state. Permit not required for exhibition.

BARROW RULES & REGULATIONS

1. The South Carolina State Fair Rules and Regulations and Open Swine Show Rules and Regulations shall apply.
2. All Barrow Exhibitors must complete a current Swine entry form which will be returned to the SC State Fair Entry Office during the Open Registration Period and placed on file for three (3) years in accordance of the National Animal Identification System (NAIS).
3. Barrow exhibitor must be minimum five (5) years of age.
4. Barrow exhibitors will be classified by the following age divisions:
 - Junior - Ages 5-13 as of January 1, 2018
 - Senior - Ages 14-19 as of January 1, 2018
 - Adult - Ages 20 & up as of January 1, 2018
5. Entries in the ON FOOT classes will be judged on (1) Average Daily Gain.

6. Only Purebred or Crossbred Barrows will be accepted.
7. Barrows will be weighed and ear tagged at the Barrow Project Kick-Off, June 22, 2018 at the SC State fairgrounds swine barn. These barrows will continue to be fed on the individual farm and brought to the Fair on Tuesday, Oct 16, 2018.
8. County Extension Agents, Vocational Agricultural Instructors, and the Extension Animal Science Staff will weigh and tag the pigs on project for the Barrow Project Show.
9. There will be two (2) weight classes for Adults as follows:
 - (1) Class 1701 - 50 to 59 pounds
 - (2) Class 1702 - 60 to 70 pounds
10. Each Farm or Firm will be allowed to enter two (2) pigs each in Classes 1701 and 1702.
11. Junior members will not be allowed to show in Classes 1701 or 1702.
12. There will be two (2) weight classes for the Junior Show as follows:
 - (1) Class 1703 - 50 to 59 pounds
 - (2) Class 1704 - 60 to 70 pounds
13. Classes 1703 and 1704 will be split into two (2) classes at the Fair by farm entry weight to allow an even number of pigs per class and will be divided as follows:
 - a. Exhibitors with two (2) pigs in a class will show one (1) pig each in Group A and B
 - b. Exhibitors with one (1) pig entered per class will be assigned by starting weight to either Group A or B.
14. These classes 1703A, 1703B, 1704A, 1704B will each have the same premiums.
15. Producers and junior members will be allowed to weigh and tag four (4) pigs per class to select two (2) to bring to the show.
16. Pigs must be castrated and healed before the weigh-in day.
17. Barrows must weigh 200 pounds or more when weighed-in on show day, #day before opening to be eligible to show. Remember, pigs lose weight in hauling (3%).
18. All barrow entries must be in barn by 9:00 am Entries will be weighed starting at 8:00 am on show day.
19. Final placing in each weight class will be determined by adding the placing in each category (On Foot and Average Daily Gain). Low score is the winner.
20. For each age division (Junior and Senior) the Final Exhibitor Placings will be determined by adding the actual placing in each class (Showmanship, Educational Contest, and Record Book) with the lowest sum placing first.
21. Plaques will be given for each class division winner in Average Daily Gain and On Foot.

22. Overall Champion: The Overall Champion is awarded a trophy (sponsored by the South Carolina Pork Board). This winner will be determined by adding the actual placing in each of the following classes: On Foot + ADG + Showmanship + Record Book + Educational Contest. The lowest number is the Overall Champion. Ties will be broken by: (1) Record Book Placing (2) Showmanship Placing (3) Average Daily Gain (ADG)
23. The premiums for Average Daily Gain and On Foot classes will be identical for all classes (Junior and Open Barrow Shows).
24. The South Carolina State Fair will provide a trophy for the Grand Champion on Foot Adult Barrow.
25. Exhibitors must make arrangements for deposition or sale of their barrows.
26. All barrows must be removed after completion of show.
27. Barrow Project exhibitors have 1 of 3 options to sale or harvest their barrows at the conclusion of the State Fair Barrow Show:
 - a. **Project buyer:** (Project buyer loads pig at conclusion of show) - youth is paid market value or contract price, to be determined at that time.
 - b. **Private buyer:** Exhibitors can contract with their own private buyer after the barrow show- youth negotiate sell price with buyer.
 - c. **Home processing:** Exhibitor will take barrow home for processing and consumption for family.

PREMIER SIRE AWARD

The South Carolina State Fair Premier Sire Award (banner) will be given in each breed with three (3) or more farms showing and at least fifteen (15) entries.

This award will be based on the following point system:

- Grand Champion: 7 Points
- Reserve Champion: 6 Points
- First in class: 5 Points
- Second in class: 4 Points
- Third in class: 3 Points
- Fourth in class: 2 Points
- Fifth in class: 1 Point

To receive points, animals must be sired by the same boar and shown in the Open Show. The South Carolina State Fair supplies the banners. Some banners may be ordered and shipped following the Swine Show. Ties will be broken first by the number of Grand Champions, then Reserve Grand Champions, First Place, Second Place, etc.

SWINE HERDSMAN AWARDS

The superintendent will make several inspections daily during the week to determine which of the exhibitors is doing the best in the following areas to keep their pens and animals in a clean and attractive environment:

1. Neatness and attractiveness of pens, signs, and feed storage.
2. Removing and replacing wet shaving and unused feed.
3. Appearance of swine at all times.
4. Exhibitors' behavior toward the public, fellow exhibitors and fair management. Exhibitors' and their employees' appearance, conduct, etc.

Winners will be announced during the Open Swine Show.
