2018 IMPORTANT DATES

- **Open Entry Registration: July 1 - Sept. 1** (*entry registration forms must be received by this date to avoid Late Fee*)
- **Late Entry Registration: Sept. 2 - Sept. 22** (*\$25 Late Fee imposed*)
- **Meat Goat Check-In/Weight-In:** Sunday, Oct. 21 – 8:00 am – 10:00 am. No exceptions. After check-in, exhibitors may unload animal and show supplies.
- **Scholarship Interviews:** Sunday, Oct 21 - 10:00 am
- **Show:** Sunday, Oct 21 - 12:30 pm
- **RELEASE:** Sunday, Oct. 21 – All animals released at conclusion of show

Late Registration Fee: \$25

TOTAL PREMIUMS OFFERED

PREMIUM CHECKS

1. Exhibitors awarded over \$599.00 must produce a valid, signed W-9 to be awarded premium (prize) monies.
2. Premiums will be paid within thirty (30) days after the close of the Fair.
3. Premium checks not cashed in ninety (90) days of issue date become void and will not be reissued.
4. Lost or stolen premium checks will not be reissued past sixty (60) days of original issue date.
5. No claim that a premium(s) has not been paid, or that there was a discrepancy in payment of the premium(s) won, will be considered when claim is made later than November 30 following the Fair.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- Show is open to youth residing in or out of South Carolina, ages 5-20 years old as of the day of the show.

ENTRY REGISTRATION

Entry Registration is required during either the Open or Late Entry Registration Period.

Register using the [Online Entry System](#) or one may register using a current South Carolina State Fair Official Youth Meat Goat entry form. Deliver completed form via Postal Mail to: **SC State Fair, Entry Office, P. O. Box 393, Columbia SC 29202.**

- Entry registration forms must be received by the closing date in the Entry Office during business hours.
- Entry registration forms received during late registration must be accompanied by the \$25 Late Fee.
- Incomplete entry forms will not be processed.

ENTRY REGISTRATION CONFIRMATION

- Online entry registrations are automatically confirmed by return email at time of submission.
- Please print and bring your confirmation on Delivery Day.
- Exhibitors who postal mail their entry registrations and desire a confirmation must include a self-addressed and stamped business size envelope.
- Please do not telephone the Fair or Entry Office.

LATE ENTRY REGISTRATION

- Entry registration forms received during Late Registration Period must be accompanied by the \$25 Late Fee.

- Late Fees may be charged to a credit/debit card (MasterCard or Visa) or money order.
- Checks will not be accepted during the Late Entry Registration Period.

PASSES & PARKING

- Exhibitors will enter through Gate 5 on George Rogers Blvd.
- Vehicle hang-tags must be purchased at the time of entry registration, as they will not be available at check-in, in the barns, or from the Superintendent.
- Junior exhibitors receive one (1) free hang-tag and may purchase additional vehicle hang-tags only at time of entry registration. Please anticipate your needs and order accordingly.
- Gate 5 vehicle hang-tags will be mailed to the Exhibitor.
- You must have a Gate 5 hang-tag displayed in vehicle in order to enter Gate 5.

IMPORTANT NOTES

- All goats must be weighed.
- Scales will close at 10:00 am on the day of the show.
- Market Classes will be broken into 3-5 weight classes depending on number of registered participants.
- Classes will be determined the day of the show.
- Either animal may be shown in showmanship by the youth in which the animal is registered under.

FEEDING AND WASHING

- Exhibitors must furnish feed and water for their animal.
- Washing areas are to be kept clean of manure, shaving and supplies when you are finished using wash rack.

CONDUCT

- Fair and show management reserve the right to remove any exhibitor from the grounds who is deemed to be mistreating any animal and/or exhibiting unsportsmanlike conduct.
- The youth must be able to maintain control their animal(s) at all times during this event.
- Parents are not allowed in the Show Ring during judging. Parents entering the ring during judging will result in the exhibitor being disqualified.
- Cloverbud exhibitors may request a senior exhibitor to accompany them in Market classes only.
- NO assistants will be allowed in Showmanship. The assistant is only allowed to step in and control the goat for the safety of the exhibitor(s) or the goat. Assistants are not allowed to lead, set-up or brace goats.
- The fair/show manager reserves the right to make decisions concerning or changing rules, regulations, and/or health requirements.
- Any animal exhibiting any significant visible symptoms of disease or sickness will not be allowed to be unloaded from the vehicle or remain on the fair/show grounds.
- All decisions by the Judge are final.

- Each exhibitor may weigh in up to six (6) does.
- Weight classes assigned morning of show.
- Goats registered in Open Doe classes are not eligible for Project Doe classes.
